

Success Story: Government Judicial Branch Resolves Publishing System slowness

Background

• Judicial Branch of the Government that oversees all court systems in the country.

Challenges/Needs

- Frequent complaints on slow access to the Publishing System (which includes critical summon information, judgements, laws, etc.). This slow access led most users to experience "404 errors".
- These complaints caused multiple delays to the whole judiciary process. Even though users were tolerating it for a long time, it was leading to increased mistrust and disinterest.

Uila Solution

- Using Uila's Application Dependency Mapping, the IT team was able to map out the entire end-to-end service for the Publishing system.
- The IT team was able to narrow down the root-cause for the slow performance to the lack of compute resources on the servers for the Publishing system.
